Whereas, The Window Film industry is committed to the education of society about all of the benefits of Window Film through a nonprofit trade association known as the International Window Film Association,

Now, Therefore, I, Charles D. Baker, Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, do hereby proclaim April 30th, 2022, to be,
