**WHEREAS**, when professionally installed on existing windows, window film aids in saving significant amounts of energy and reducing carbon emissions; and

**WHEREAS**, window film helps to screen out dangerous UV rays to protect skin from cancer and eyes from glare; and

**WHEREAS**, nearly 80 percent of all window film in the world is manufactured in the United States by leading companies and offers significant economic benefits at multiple levels; and

**WHEREAS**, by lowering energy costs, especially during seasonal changes, window film greatly impacts citizens and their ability to pay for utility services; window film installation also provides job opportunities and allows people to serve their communities; and

**WHEREAS**, the window film industry helps both consumers and businesses save money on their energy bills and reduces demand for electricity when utilities are most challenged.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Michael L. Parson, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, do hereby proclaim April 30, 2022, to be

in Missouri.
