Executive Order

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

**WHEREAS,** window film, when professionally installed on existing windows, ensures safe, secure environments for home and vehicle owners, public buildings, and retail establishments and provides significant energy savings; and

**WHEREAS,** 80 percent of all window film in the world is manufactured in the United States and offers significant benefits to employment, energy savings, health, and reduced carbon footprints; and

**WHEREAS,** window film helps screen out dangerous solar rays from affecting the health of commercial drivers to help protect them from skin cancer and solar glare; and

**WHEREAS,** the window film industry contributes to a strong economy in Indiana by providing consumers and businesses a cost effective means of saving energy and creating job opportunities in communities throughout the commonwealth; and

**WHEREAS,** National Window Film Day is an opportunity to acknowledge the men and women in the industry who manufacture, distribute, and install window film;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb,** Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim April 30, 2023 as

**WINDOW FILM DAY**

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
