BY THE  
GOVERNOR

TO THE PEOPLE OF KANSAS, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, when professionally installed on existing windows, window film significantly aids in saving energy and reducing carbon emissions; and

WHEREAS, window film blocks dangerous UV rays and helps protect skin from cancer and eyes from glare; and

WHEREAS, window film provides job opportunities for people to serve their communities; and

WHEREAS, nearly 80 percent of all window film in the world is manufactured in the United States by leading companies and offers significant economic benefits at all levels.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Laura Kelly, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF KANSAS, do hereby proclaim April 30, 2023, as

National Window Film Day

in the state of Kansas, and I urge all citizens to join in this observation.
